THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WORK SESSION BEGAN AT 6:00 P.M. AND THE REGULAR MEETING WAS IMMEDIATELY CALLED TO ORDER BY MR. FRANK COUGHLIN, PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL. AN EXECUTIVE SESSION WAS HELD ON MARCH 21, 2019 AND APRIL 8, 2019 REGARDING REAL ESTATE MATTERS.

CITIZEN'S REQUESTS AND COMMENTS REGARDING AGENDA ITEMS

THERE WERE NO QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS REGARDING AGENDA ITEMS.

CITIZENS REQUESTS AND COMMENTS REGARDING GENERAL ITEMS

MS. PHYLLIS SCOTT ASKED AS A RESIDENT OF THE BOROUGH FOR OVER FIFTEEN YEARS IF THERE WAS A STRATEGIC PLAN EVEN BEING CONSIDERED TO REVERSE THE DETERIORATION OF THIS BOROUGH. MR. COUGHLIN SAID THAT THEY HAVE BEEN WORKING ON THAT BY PASSING ORDINANCES ON BLIGHT, DEMOLISHED FIVE BLIGHTED BUILDINGS. HE SAID THEY ARE ALSO VOTING ON ITEM NUMBER TWO IN THE AGENDA WHICH DEALS WITH REVITALIZATION. HE SAID EVERYTHING IS DONE IN SLOW STEPS. MR. COUGHLIN SAID MS. SPECE HAD A MEETING WITH THE MAYOR OF PITTSTON SO THAT COUNCIL COULD PARTNER WITH PITTSTON ON A FEW THINGS. MR. COUGHLIN SAID THAT COUNCIL IS TRYING TO MOVE FORWARD.

MR. DIXON SAID PLYMOUTH BOROUGH WAS AWARDED GRANTS AND ARE TAKING DOWN BLIGHTED PROPERTIES. HE SAID THAT THEY ALSO HAVE REPAIRED NUMEROUS DRAINS THROUGHOUT THE BOROUGH. MS. SCOTT SAID THAT IS ALL WELL NEEDED AND APPRECIATED. MS. SCOTT SAID MS. SPECE IS THE GRANT PERSON WHICH IS A GOOD THING BECAUSE THAT IS WHERE THEY WILL GET THE MONEY. SHE SAID WHEN SHE DROVE INTO TOWN THAT DAY THAT SHE COUNTED 24 VACANT COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES. THAT DOES NOT GIVE THE APPEARANCE THAT EITHER OTHER STORES, COMMERCIAL

VENTURES, OR OTHER BUSINESSES WOULD WANT TO BE THERE. MR. COUGHLIN STATED THAT WAS WHAT HE JUST SPOKE ABOUT THAT IT IS ITEM NUMBER 2 ON THE AGENDA. MR. DIXON SAID THAT MS. SPECE HAS GONE TO COUNTLESS NUMBER OF CLASSES AND HAS BEEN REACHING OUT TO OTHER COMMUNITIES.

MR. COUGHLIN RECOGNIZED MRS. HEATHER RUSESKAS. MRS. RUSESKAS SAID SHE IS A RESIDENT OF PLYMOUTH AND THE VICE REGION OF THE WYOMING VALLEY CHAPTER OF THE DAUGHTERS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION. SHE SAID THAT IT WAS THE OLDEST CHAPTER IN THE STATE. SHE SAID THEY NOTICED THAT THE FLAG IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING COULD BE REPLACED AND SHE WAS THERE TO PRESENT A FLAG TO COUNCIL. THERE WAS A ROUND OF APPLAUSE AND ALL OF COUNCIL THANKED HER.

MEETING AGENDA

1. MOTION: I HEREBY MOVE THAT THE COUNCIL APPROVE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY THE BOROUGH OFFICIALS LISTED BELOW TO BE PLACED ON THE CHECKING ACCOUNTS AND BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ALL CHECKS THAT DRAW ON THE BOROUGH ACCOUNTS AT FIRST KEYSTONE COMMUNITY BANK AND TO SIGN ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY THE AFOREMENTIONED BANK IN ORDER TO DO SO. THE BOROUGH OFFICIALS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN ARE: FRANK COUGHLIN, PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL, WILLIAM DIXON, VICE-PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND HOLLY SPECE, BOROUGH SECRETARY AND TREASURER.

MR. DIXON MADE THE MOTION.

MR. CUNNINGHAM CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

MR. COUGHLIN EXPLAINED THAT THIS MOTION IS ON THE AGENDA BECAUSE MR. COUGHLIN WAS NOMINATED FOR THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND MR. DIXON WAS NOMINATED FOR VICE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL. MR.

KOCHINSKI'S NAME WAS STILL LISTED ON THE ACCOUNTS AND NOW THAT WILL BE RECTIFIED.

ALL OF COUNCIL APPROVED THE MOTION EXCEPT FOR MRS. MANGLAVITI WHO ABSTAINED FROM VOTING.

2. MOTION: TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL FROM PENNSYLVANIA DOWNTOWN CENTER TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC VISION AND REVITALIZATION PLAN AND ISSUE PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$3,912.50).

MR. CUNNINGHAM MADE THE MOTION.

MS. MANGLAVITI CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

MR. COUGHLIN SAID THIS IS THE GROUP WHO WILL HELP FORMULATE A PLAN. HE SAID THEY DID HAVE A PLAN YEARS AGO AND THAT THEY WILL UTILIZE IT WHILE DRAFTING THIS NEW PLAN.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

3. MOTION: TO ISSUE THE LOCAL SHARE AWARDED AMOUNT TO WYOMING VALLEY WEST SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR COMPLETION OF THE FIRST PHASE OF THE HIGH SCHOOL ROOF PROJECT.

MR. DIXON MADE THE MOTION.

MR. PETERS CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

MR. COUGHLIN SAID THIS WAS GRANT THAT WAS RECEIVED LAST YEAR. HE SAID HE SPOKE MANY TIMES ABOUT THE LSA GRANTS. HE SAID BOROUGH, TOWNSHIPS AND CITIES ARE THE ONLY ENTITIES THAT ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. HE SAID WYOMING VALLEY WEST NEEDED WORK AND THE BOROUGH APPLIED FOR THEM. HE SAID THAT HAS NOTHING TO DO WITH OUR MONEY OR WHETHER OR NOT WE ARE AWARDED.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

4. MOTION: TO APPROVE THE PAYMENT TO TRACTOR AND SUPPLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE ZERO TURN MOWER AND ACCESSORIES IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$6,978.88).

MR. CUNNINGHAM MADE THE MOTION.

MRS. EROH CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

MR. COUGHLIN SAID THEY ARE TRYING TO KEEP ON THE BOROUGH'S EQUIPMENT AND NOT HAVE EVERYTHING GO BAD AT THE SAME TIME.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

5. MOTION: TO OPEN THE PLYMOUTH BOROUGH UNFUNDED DEBT VEHICLE PURCHASE FUND AT FIRST KEYSTONE COMMUNITY BANK.

MR. CUNNINGHAM MADE THE MOTION.

MRS. EROH CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

6. MOTION: TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FOR THE COUNCIL MEETINGS THAT WERE HELD ON JANUARY 8, 2019, FEBRUARY 12, 2019, AND MARCH 12, 2019.

MR. THOMAS MADE THE MOTION.

MR. PETERS CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

ALL OF COUNCIL APPROVED THE MOTION EXCEPT FOR MR. COUGHLIN WHO APPROVED THE MARCH 12, 2019 COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES BUT ABSTAINED FROM JANUARY 8, 2019 AND FEBRUARY 12, 2019 COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES.

7. MOTION: TO APPROVE MONTHLY FIRE, POLICE AND TREASURER'S REPORTS.

MR. CUNNINGHAM MADE THE MOTION.

MS. MANGLAVITI CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

8. MOTION: TO PAY MARCH BILLS.

GENERAL FUND: 19-239-19-308

LIQUID FUEL FUND: 19-036-19-047

RECREATION FUND: 19-015-19-019

MR. DIXON MADE THE MOTION.

MRS. EROH CALLED THE SECOND ON THE MOTION.

MR. COUGHLIN SAID THE ALL THE BILLS ARE AVAILABLE FOR VIEW DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.

THE MOTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED EXCEPT FOR MR. THOMAS WHO FAVORABLY VOTED FOR PAYMENT ON ALL BILLS EXCEPT HIS SUPPLEMENTAL INSURANCES FOR WHICH HE HAS A PERSONAL INTEREST BECAUSE OF CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS.

MS. MANGLAVITI ANNOUNCED THAT SHE WANTED TO MAKE A STATEMENT. SHE STATED, "LAST MONTH THIS COUNCIL TOOK A VOTE FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT. UNFORTUNATELY, IT WENT VERY QUICKLY AND I FELT UNPREPARED FOR AN ANSWER AND I VOTED FOR MR. DIXON AS VICE PRESIDENT. I AM ASHAMED OF MYSELF FOR MAKING THAT DECISION. I'D LIKE TO TELL YOU WHY THAT I DON'T BELIEVE THAT MR. DIXON SHOULD BE VICE PRESIDENT. I TURNED IN MY LETTER OF INTEREST TO THIS COUNCIL IN NOVEMBER OF 2017. I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM MR. DIXON ASKING TO COME TO MY HOME TO INTERVIEW ME. ALTHOUGH THIS WAS UNUSUAL, I WAS LOOKING TO WORK WITH A GROUP OF RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS WHOM I COULD BUILD A GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP, SO I AGREED. MR. DIXON LATER CALLED ME AGAIN AND ASKED THAT I COME TO HIS HOME FOR THE INTERVIEW. I WENT. I ANSWERED HIS QUESTIONS AND RECEIVED HIS SUPPORT. LOOKING BACK, I SHOULD HAVE QUESTIONED WHY AN INTERVIEW WOULD TAKE PLACE ANYWHERE OTHER THAN THE BOROUGH BUILDING. ON JUNE 23, 2018, SEVERAL MEMBERS OF COUNCIL ATTENDED A SOCIAL FUNCTION. IT WAS A GREAT TIME WITH MUSIC AND DANCING. I ASKED MR. DIXON FOR A DANCE. AFTER ONE DANCE, MR. DIXON TOLD ME I OWED HIM ONE. I DIDN'T THINK ANYTHING OF THIS BECAUSE I'VE HEARD MR. DIXON USE THIS TERM BEFORE AND HE APPEARED TO BE JOKING AROUND. A DAY OR TWO PRIOR MS. SPECE ASKED ME TO HELP HER WORK ON A PROJECT TO VERIFY ADDRESSES. I ASSUMED THIS WAS WHAT THAT MR. DIXON WANTED TO TALK TO ME ABOUT BECAUSE HE DID SAY HE WANTED TO TALK TO ME AFTER HE TOLD ME I OWED HIM ONE. THE NEXT DAY, MR. DIXON CALLED ME ON SUNDAY THE 24TH. HE SAID HE WANTED TO MEET ME AT MY HOUSE AND WANTED TO TALK AND WANTED TO KNOW WHEN I WOULD BE AVAILABLE. I THOUGHT NOTHING OF THIS SINCE THE EPISODE WITH THE INTERVIEW SIX MONTHS EARLIER. I TOLD MR. DIXON THAT I WOULD BE AVAILABLE TUESDAY MORNING AT 10:00 AM. EARLIER THAT MORNING, OF TUESDAY, JUNE 26, I RECEIVED A CALL FROM MS. SPECE ABOUT VERIFYING ADDRESSES. I TOLD HER THAT I HAD AN APPOINTMENT TO MEET MR. DIXON AT 10:00 AM AND I WAS SURE THAT'S WHAT HE WANTED TO TALK ABOUT.

MR. DIXON SHOWED UP TO MY DOOR AT APPROXIMATELY 9:50 AM. I OPENED THE DOOR TO LET HIM IN. ONCE INSIDE THE HOUSE, MR. DIXON GRABBED ME BY THE WAIST, PULLED ME IN AND TRIED TO KISS ME. WITH BOTH HANDS I PUSHED HIM AWAY STARTLED AND ASKED HIM WHAT HE THOUGHT HE WAS DOING. MR. DIXON REPLIED YOU KNOW WHY I'M HERE. I ASSURED HIM I BELIEVED HE WAS THERE TO TALK ABOUT BOROUGH BUSINESS. MR. DIXON PLEADED WITH ME TO HAVE SEX WITH HIM."

MR. COUGHLIN INTERJECTED AND SAID THAT HE THOUGHT THEY WENT FAR ENOUGH WITH THIS. MR. DIXON SAID THAT IT WAS A LIE. MS. MANGLAVITI SAID SHE WANTED TO FINISH HER STORY. MR. COUGHLIN ASKED THE SOLICITOR HIS OPINION. MR. KOSTELANSKY SAID TO LET HER FINISH.

MS. MANGLAVITI CONTINUED WITH HER STATEMENT. SHE CONTINUED HER STATEMENT BY SAYING, "MR. DIXON WAS THERE ABOUT TEN MINUTES. HE REPEATED AGAIN AND AGAIN JUST ONE TIME JUST THINK ABOUT IT. I WAS ALONE, THERE WAS NO NEIGHBORS HOME THAT MORNING AND NO ONE WOULD BE ABLE TO SEE OR HEAR ME. AFTER ABOUT TEN MINUTES I WAS ABLE TO GET MR. DIXON CALMLY AND SAFELY OUT OF MY HOUSE. HE CONTINUED TELLING ME TO THINK ABOUT IT AS HE WALKED OUT THE DOOR AND ASKED ME TO CALL HIM. I WOULD HAVE SAID ANYTHING TO GET HIM OUT OF MY HOUSE. AS QUICKLY AS HE PULLED OUT OF MY DRIVEWAY, I GRABBED MY KEYS AND IMMEDIATELY WENT TO THE BOROUGH BUILDING TO REPORT WHAT HAD JUST HAPPENED. MR. KOCHINSKI, WHO IS IN THE BACK, WAS HERE AT THE BOROUGH BUILDING. I WAS VERY SHAKEN AND AFTER REPORTING THE INCIDENT I WAS ASKED HOW I WANTED TO HANDLE THE SITUATION. I EXPLAINED I'D ONLY BEEN ON COUNCIL SIX MONTHS AND I DIDN'T WANT THIS TO OVERSHADOW ALL THE GOOD WE WERE DOING IN TOWN. MR. KOCHINSKI AGREED. I DECIDED NOT TO TAKE ACTION BUT IT WAS REPORTED IN CASE ANYTHING WERE TO HAPPEN. AS SOON AS MY NEIGHBOR RETURNED HOME FROM WORK, SUE CORCHOSE WHO'S HERE, I REPORTED TO HER WHAT HAD HAPPENED AND I HAD ASKED HER TO KEEP AN EYE OUT AND IF SHE WERE TO SEE MR. DIXON'S TRUCK COME UP MY DRIVEWAY TO CALL FOR HELP. AFTER THE INCIDENT, MR. DIXON WAS CALLING ME REGULARLY SOMETIMES TWO OR THREE TIMES A DAY. I WOULD NOT ANSWER THE CALLS OR LISTEN TO THE VOICEMAILS. IT WAS WEEKS BEFORE I COULD BRING MYSELF TO SPEAK TO HIM BUT I KNEW WE WERE GOING TO HAVE TO WORK TOGETHER. I WAS SO UPSET I CONSULTED WITH AN ATTORNEY AND I CONFRONTED MR. DIXON HERE AT THE BOROUGH BUILDING IN THIS ROOM. I TOLD HIM THAT I HAD NO RESPECT FOR HIM AND THAT I WAS CONSIDERING TAKING ACTION. HE SAID HE DID NOT CARE WHAT I DID. IT WAS NOT MY INTENTION TO OPEN THIS TO THE PUBLIC. I STRUGGLED WITH THIS FOR A LONG TIME AND LOST A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF SLEEP OVER IT. IT WAS NOT MY INTENTION TO HURT ANYONE. I DID NOT HURT MR. DIXON'S FAMILY OR HIS REPUTATION. MR. DIXON DID THAT WHEN HE ATTEMPTED TO SOLICIT SEX. MR. DIXON HAS DISPLAYED A COMPLETE LACK OF RESPECT FOR ME, FOR HIS POSITION AS A BOROUGH COUNCILMAN AND TO HIS FAMILY. AT TIMES I WORRY ABOUT MY SAFETY AND WELL-BEING. I MADE A COMMITMENT TO YOU AND TO THIS COUNCIL TO DO WHAT IS BEST FOR PLYMOUTH AND I WILL STAND BY THAT. I WAS WRONG TO VOTE FOR MR. DIXON AS VICE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL. HE IS NOT THE PERSON I WANT REPRESENTING YOU OR ME. I DIDN'T HAVE THE COURAGE TO TELL YOU WHY AND I APOLOGIZE FOR THAT. IT WAS ALSO BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION BY MR. KOCHINSKI THAT MR. DIXON HELD THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL IN THE PAST. HE WAS REMOVED FROM THAT POSITION. I WAS NOT HERE AT THE TIME AND I

CANNOT SPECULATE AS TO WHY BUT IT MAY BE IN YOUR BEST INTEREST TO ASK THE QUESTION. WHAT WAS THE REASON MR. DIXON WAS REMOVED AS PRESIDENT? THANK YOU.”

MR. COUGHLIN PROVIDED MR. DIXON A CHANCE TO RESPOND TO MS. MANGLAVITI’S STATEMENT. MR. DIXON SAID THAT HE DID AND SAID HE KIND OF KNEW WHAT WAS GOING ON. HE SAID THAT THEY WERE AT A PARTY AND EVERYONE WAS DRINKING. HE SAID THAT HE DID SAY THAT TO HER AND THAT SHE TOLD HIM TO COME HER HOUSE SO HE WENT TO HER HOUSE. HE SAID THAT HE DID NOT PUT HIS HANDS ON HER. HE SAID HE KNOCKED AT THE DOOR SHE SAID THAT SHE DID NOT HAVE HER MAKEUP ON SO HE SAID THAT HE DID NOT CARE AND HE CAME IN AND SHE SAID TO HIM THAT THEY WERE NOT DOING ANYTHING. MR. DIXON SAID THAT WAS WHAT SHE SAID AND THAT HE APOLOGIZED TO HER AND HE SAID HE WALKED OUT OF THE HOUSE BECAUSE HE IS GENTLEMAN. HE SAID THEY WERE ALL DRINKING AND SHE WAS SITTING ON, OTHER EVENTS, SHE WAS SITTING ON DIFFERENT GUYS LAPS AND MS. MANGLAVITI SAID IT WAS A LIE. MR. DIXON INSISTED THAT IT WAS SO. HE SAID AT MR. KOCHINSKI’S PARTY, THEY WERE ALL DRINKING AND HE WAS DANCING WITH HER AND SHE CAME OVER PULLING ON HIM AND SAID HE WAS WRONG TO EVEN THINK TO DO THAT. MR. DIXON ADMITS THAT BUT INSISTS THE HE DID NOT TOUCH HER. HE SAID MS. MANGLAVITI CALLED HIM IN TO THE OFFICE AND SHE SAID WHEN I WAS GOING UP FOR PRESIDENT BECAUSE MR. KOCHINSKI, MS. SPECE AND MS. MAGLAVITI WAS SITTING IN HERE BECAUSE THEY WERE GROOMING HER PRESIDENT AND MR. DIXON SAID HE WOULD LIKE TO RUN FOR PRESIDENT. MR. DIXON SAID MR. KOCHINSKI NEVER CALLED HIM BACK ANYMORE. HE SAID THAT MS. MANGLAVITI SAID IF HE DID THAT TO HER THERE WAS GOING TO BE OTHERS AND MR. DIXON SAID GOOD LUCK AND ADDED THAT THERE IS NOBODY. MR. DIXON SAID THAT MS. MANGLAVITI SAID SHE WAS GOING TO GET A LAWYER AND HE SAID GO AHEAD AND GET A LAWYER. HE SAID THAT IT WAS WRONG OF HER TO COME UP HERE IN PUBLIC LIKE THIS BECAUSE IF SHE WAS REALLY THAT SCARED, AND WHEN HE CALLED HER HE WAS CALLING HER FOR DIFFERENT EVENTS AND SHE COULD VERIFY THAT WHEN GAIL OR ONE OF THEM WOULD TELL HIM TO CALL HER FOR SOMETHING AND IT WAS STRICTLY BUSINESS. HE SAID THAT WAS WRONG AND HE ADMITS THAT HE WAS WRONG AND HE WAS A PERFECT GENTLEMAN AND SAID SHE WANTS TO BRING THIS OUT HERE AND SHE SAID THAT SHE CARED ABOUT HIS FAMILY. HE SAID IF SHE CARED ABOUT HIS FAMILY, SHE WOULD HAVE GOT ALL OF COUNCIL TOGETHER WHICH SHE DID NOT DO AND THAT HE APOLOGIZED TO HER AND WALKED OUT OF HER HOUSE. HE SAID HE DOES NOT PLAY THAT AND THAT HE DOES NOT TOUCH OR GRAB WOMEN. HE SAID HE DOES NOT DO THAT, NEVER IN HIS LIFE. HE SAID SHE WAS WRONG BECAUSE SHE HAS THE MOTIVE. MR. DIXON SAID THAT SHE WANTED TO BE PRESIDENT AND IT PISSED HER OFF. MR. DIXON SAID THAT SHE WAS NOT ELECTED AND THAT SHE WAS APPOINTED AND WHAT DOES SHE REALLY KNOW. HE SAID SHE’S ONLY BEEN ON COUNCIL FOR A FEW MONTHS. HE SAID THAT HE WAS UP FOR ELECTION AND SAID GOOD LUCK. MR. DIXON SAID THAT THEY ALL PLAYED THEIR GAME AND THAT THEY ALL GOT TOGETHER AND THAT’S FINE. HE SAID BUT NO MATTER WHAT, HE COULD LOSE THIS ELECTION BUT HE WILL STILL SERVE THIS COMMUNITY. MR. DIXON APOLOGIZED TO THE PUBLIC AND ADDED THAT’S BECAUSE HE HAS A WONDERFUL WIFE AND FAMILY AND HE IS THE ONE THAT MADE THE MISTAKE BY EVEN GOING TO HER HOUSE AND HE ADMITS IT.
