The Borough will be contributing a deposit of \$35,000.00 and financing remaining balance of \$300,000.00 with a Qualified Tax-Exempt Loan from Wayne Bank for a term of 15 years with 5.26% interest rate. I further move to authorize, President of Council and Vice-President of Council to sign on behalf of the borough and designate the Borough Secretary to attest, as needed.

OTQ: This is all part of the process, not quite finished but getting close. We're still in process of the deed search, will need to pass an ordinance, and get DCED approval. We're making sure everything is in line.
