

ORDINANCE NO. 4 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PLYMOUTH PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A POLICE PROCESSING FEE FOR INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED FOR A CRIME AND TRANSPORTED TO LUZERNE COUNTY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTE FOR INCARCERATION

WHEREAS, the Borough Police Department from time to time must arrest and take person(s) into custody for crimes which require processing. Processing may include but are not limited to; fingerprinting, photographing, inventory of personal property, storage, transferring personal property, transporting to and from Magisterial District Courts and/or correctional facilities and other requirements of processing upon arrest;

WHEREAS, the taking of the inventory, transferring the property over to the staff of the correctional facility involves paperwork in order to not only document the property turned over to the correctional facility but to obtain a receipt for the same;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Plymouth Borough Council that in order to recoup the costs associated both in time and paperwork involved in processing a person arrested as outlined in the first paragraph above and incorporated herein by reference thereto, thus does hereby impose upon said arrested individual a processing fee of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars to be collected as part of restitution upon the sentencing of the arrested individual by the Court after either a conviction, by plea or conviction after trial.

This Ordinance shall become effective as provide for in § 3301.3 (b) of the Borough Code.
